Dear Parents and Guardians of the Maple Run Unified School District Students:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that there are two unfilled slots in the new Maple Run Elementary Transfer Program. We have had several inquiries after the deadline, so for this FIRST YEAR ONLY we are holding a lottery to fill those two slots. These are not options to hold open, the two students selected will be committed and enrolled in their school of choice. Please complete the attached application and return it to Central Office no later than June 21. The two selected will be notified by July 1.

Below is the original letter sent to parents in March. Attached are the procedures, application form and FAQs.

Dear Parents and Guardians of the Maple Run Unified School District Students:

As you know, as of July 1, 2017, Franklin Central Supervisory Union will cease to exist and will turn into Maple Run Unified School District. Becoming a single school district comprised of five schools allows us some additional ways to benefit our students.

One of these ways is to allow a limited number of students to transfer from one elementary school into one of the other two participating elementary schools in our district. Once accepted, the student is able to attend the receiving school through the end of grade 8. It is important to note that, unless available, transportation is not provided.

If you are interested in having your child take part in the program, please obtain an application and program description from your child's school's website or from the FCSU website (fcsuvt.org.). Complete the form and return it to the address on the form by April 15, 2017. You may also request the form from the Superintendent's Office at 28 Catherine St. in St. Albans (802-524-2600 X11). If more than the allowable number of students apply and there are limited openings, a lottery system will be utilized to determine the students who may transfer.
